



CoJourners Training Series : Level 1

Week 4: Sharing the Message

Purpose:

Practical training in effectively sharing the gospel with friends and acquaintances.

Preparation:

1. Download the set of four "Guide" cards and the "Big Six Evangelism Training."
2. Print out enough copies for everyone in the group

Plan:

1. **Discuss** last week's assignment. Were you able to ask one question (from the Power Tools) to some people last week? How did it go?
2. **Read:** the first two paragraphs of the card. Look up the passages mentioned, Romans 1:16 and Romans 10:14,15.
3. **Discuss:** the first question, "On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you that you can clearly explain the gospel to others and lead them to Christ".

4. Action Plan:

1. Get together with your group individually or altogether, maybe eat a meal together and go over the "Big Six" training. This will train each person in how to use the "How would You Like To Know God Personally?" booklet.
2. Read through each of the 4 "Guide" cards once this week during your personal devotional time.

Next Week: You will be covering the "Embarking Together" card on the same sheet of 4 cards. Be sure to everyone to bring the sheet of the four cards back with them for the next week's Bible study training time. Next week, your group will learn how to ask permission as they seek to share the gospel with their friends.

Showing the Way

2 A guide must not only know the way, he or she must have the ability to show the way to others. The way to Jesus is found in the gospel. Read Romans 1:16 and Romans 10:14, 15.

You understood the gospel when someone explained it to you. You will also learn to share the gospel as others show you how. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8 and 2 Timothy 2:2.

3 Discuss

• On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you that you can clearly explain the gospel to others and lead them to Christ?

- Who do you know who could teach you how to communicate the gospel effectively?

You may learn to share the gospel from someone with more experience, such as your Bible study leader, a Christian leader, etc. Or, you may attend a training seminar or read a book on witnessing.

Make a plan with your small group to get training in how to share the gospel with others.
